SPECIFICS

COST

The approximate fee for Junior Varsity Winter Guard will be \$360 for all members. This fee will be broken down into 3 monthly payments. Some families never have to write a check due to their participation in fundraisers. More information will be available at the band booster meeting.

Please go through these and list any conflicts on the "Signature Page" prior to returning to staff. Please know that attendance is crucial and can be a factor in membership into the guard program.

MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

Please read the following:

1. As a member, I understand that my academic achievement is most important. If my name appears on the ineligibility list, I realize that my performance position may be in jeopardy. Students must plan ahead to keep up with the busy spring schedule. Proper study habits are very important. **Members will not be excused for missing rehearsal due to poor time management**, as this will jeopardize the success of the entire ensemble.

2. As a member, I understand it will take sacrifices in other areas of my life to be a part of this performing group. I will **always** be on time for rehearsal. **The following absences from rehearsals will not be excused: non-emergency doctor/dentist appointments, employment responsibilities, social activities, study sessions, and family functions.** Unexcused absences and/or excessive tardiness will result in dismissal from the group. **All absences for rehearsals must be cleared in advance.** A previous history of un-excused absences could result in lack of membership.

3. As a member, I realize that there are numerous hours of rehearsal needed before the finished product is complete and that it is mandatory I attend every rehearsal. The only excused absences that would be considered are severe sickness or a death in the immediate family. If an emergency such as this does occur, I will get in contact with a staff member immediately. Please leave a message if there is no answer. Missed rehearsals prior to performances will result in the student being sidelined for that performance.

4. As a member, I realize that it is mandatory to attend all performances. Any potential conflicts for rehearsals or performances should be noted in the “conflicts” area on the Contact Page.

5. As a member, I understand that there may be 1 to 2 extra rehearsals and/or sectionals (other than regularly scheduled). It is my responsibility to the group to attend these sectionals.

6. As a member, I understand that I am to have all necessary items for practices and performances. I understand that failure to be prepared for rehearsal or a performance can result in loss of points in my grade, and/or not performing at event or upcoming event.

7. As a member, I understand that I am responsible for the Membership Fee, as well as other items that may be necessary, as listed in this packet.

8. The image of the Southmoore Guard is very important. As a member, I understand that I am representing the group at all times, even when not with the group, and that I must maintain the highest level of professionalism. Unacceptable behavior, inappropriate attire, extreme hair color and non-conventional body piercing are not allowed. Any changes to a student's appearance must be pre-approved by staff, since appearance directly affects the look of the group. This includes hair color, haircuts, piercings, etc.

9. There may be alternate membership positions. At any time, an alternate may be placed into a performing position. Likewise, a performing member may lose their spot due to grades, eligibility, finances, discipline, excessive absences, poor work ethic, or level of performance. In addition, **I understand that all performers may not perform every segment of the show.**

10. We urge parents to encourage their students to practice at home. The instructional staff chooses performers for spots based on their skills and progression.

11. Students will obey and show respect toward directors, instructional staff and chaperones at all times. Respect toward other members is mandatory at all times.

12. If the student has a medical or physical condition that could interfere with participation or performing, the performer must notify the staff immediately.

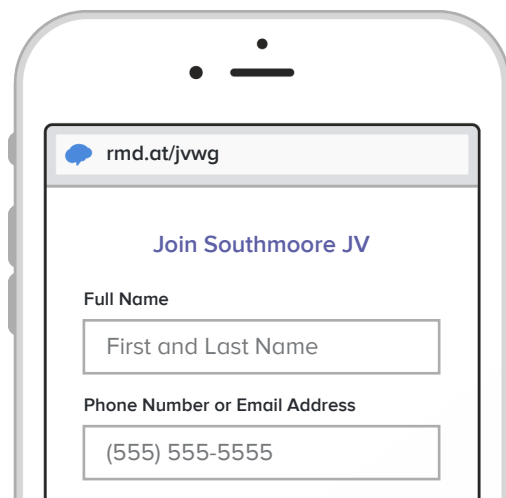

All contests and rehearsals are mandatory.

- Rehearsals will begin Monday, November 26th at Plaza Towers Elementary.
- Rehearsals are on **Mondays** and **Thursdays** from **4:00-6:00PM** until March 30th.
- There will be a few drill design rehearsals on Saturdays. These rehearsal dates and times will be on the calendar handout.
- ***Members who are unable to attend rehearsals for extended periods of time (ex. wedding, leaving the state, cruise, etc.) are required to give Ms. Wessel the dates, times, and reason for leave.
 - At least **one-week notification** is required for absences. Please **do not** contact Ms. Wessel via Facebook Messenger or any other social media. These are often missed. Email swessel@cnpschools.org for any absences or emergencies.
 - **Members are responsible** for catching up on missed skills and/or choreography outside of rehearsal time with an assigned member.
 - If a member is unable to make-up the missed material by the designated time frame, he or she **may not receive a guaranteed spot** in the upcoming season (i.e. alternate).
 - **Only emergency situations are excused absences from rehearsal (i.e. death in the family, hospitalization, etc.)**

-The attached contract and deposit is due by Thursday, November 29th.

-The Southmoore Winter Guard's fees for Junior Varsity members are \$360. Dues must be paid in full by Thursday, January 10th.

-These fees and due dates will be discussed at the Parent meeting. Fees are used to purchase new equipment, silks, costumes, paint, etc. Please turn your money in on time so we can have everything we need for every performance!

-You must pay by cash/check, (Checks written out to Southmoore Band) please enclose your payment in an envelope and label with student's name, amount, and what the money is for (fees, jacket, bag, etc.).

- **Weapon Fees** (only applies to those interested in auditioning for the weapon line who **do not** already have a rifle or sabre)
 - ☞ King Kong Rifle \$55 due ASAP at the latest November 29th
 - ☞ Synthetic King Sabre \$125 or King Sabre \$215 due ASAP at the latest November 29th
 - ☞ Fingerless Gloves \$16 (required for weapon line) due ASAP at the latest November 29th

- **Additional fees NOT included in the dues.**
 - Appropriate undergarments needed for the 2019 costumes (TBA)
 - 2019 Show Make-up (TBA)
 - Each member is required to have the appropriate athletic/comfortable clothing for all rehearsals. Junior Varsity Winter Guard is a movement-driven activity and proper rehearsal attire is necessary. No jeans/denim is allowed.
 - For each show flag silk significantly damaged during the season, they must be fixed professionally (i.e. alterations store) or a fee of \$10 dollars will be charged per damaged silk (significant tears, holes, stains, or rips). This does not include previous silk damage.

-Opportunities for students to fundraise in order to pay for all or part of their expenses are currently being distributed. Take advantage of this if needed!
