

AUDIO WALKS

There are three specially commissioned audio walks included in your programme.

They are just like the audio guides you use in museums and galleries, but out on the street!

Full of music and fascinating stories, they will unlock the secrets of the city around you. Have fun!

Each audio guided walk has a duration of approximately 2 hours.

All walks have been carefully researched by historians, scripted and performed by professional writers and actors.

How to use enjoy the audio walks

In December we will provide you with access to the audio files for all three walks.

Every passenger in your group will need to download the files on to their smart phone or tablet device, and importantly, save the files for offline use.

They will need to bring headphones with them on the trip.

We will provide a maps and instructions for each walk in the itinerary book that everyone will receive on their arrival in London.

So, all you need to do is follow the instructions for where the walk starts, we provide the nearest underground station and the start point.

You then just need to open the audio files on your phone or tablet for the walk you are on and click on the first track. Once that is finished you will be instructed to walk to the next stop, also noted on the accompanying map, and press play again.

Never walk and listen to the audio at the same time. Pause the next track before you walk. Look at your maps while you listen to the directions. Keep your eyes open and be aware of your surroundings. That's it, have fun!

The walks that are included in your programme:

LNYPD Parade Route. This takes you along the magnificent New Year's Day Parade route. Discover where you'll be marching, what you'll be passing, and where the crowds will be cheering from. This walk also includes important parade participation information.

Southbank Stroll. A unique riverside walk along the traffic free South Bank of the River Thames through the historic Borough of Southwark, featuring The Shakespearean Globe Playhouse, the iconic Millennium Bridge, Southwark Cathedral home of the Harvard Chapel and the fabulous Borough food Market.

London, Rock and Roll Capital of the world. This immersive walk takes you along the streets and in the footsteps of some of the biggest and best legends in the history of rock, including The Beatles, The Rolling Stones, Bowie, Elvis, and many more. This is the world of the Swinging Sixties, Glam Rock, and Punk Rock.

Additional walks that will be available on request

Harry Potter. From the cinema where all the premieres were screened to the site of Platform 9 ^¾, this walk takes in the instantly recognisable London locations of the famous movie series, including Diagon Alley, Brockdale Bridge and the Third Hand Book Emporium.

Princes, Palaces and Power. Walk shoulder to shoulder with royalty as we travel through over 1000 years of British history, pomp and pageantry. Sites include the Palace of Westminster, Big Ben, and Buckingham Palace. And come face to face with living history as you watch the famous Changing of the Guard.
